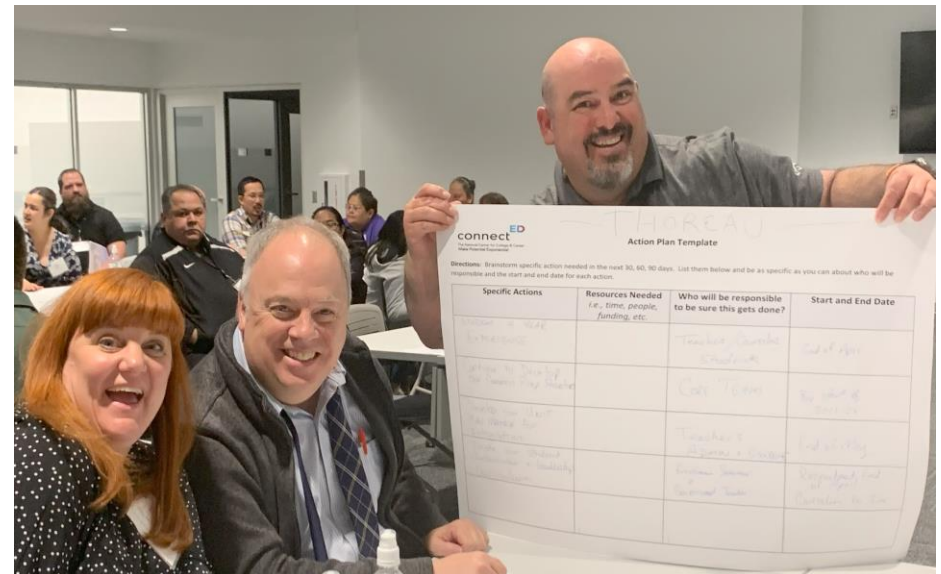


## Learning Rounds
